Community Advisory Committee

The CAC met on February 23 at Lane County Youth Services. Tara DaVee gave the Governing Board report; Rick Kincade shared the report from the CAP. Debi Farr gave an update on the legislative highlights. Char reported on the RAC and gave an overview of the Lower Umpqua Hospital District meeting.

The Transformation Center is hosting a CAC Summit in Sunriver, June 2 and 3. Funding will be available to help with transportation and housing, but the process is not set up yet. It is likely that we will be able to send 3 people from the CAC and three from the RAC.

Jennifer Jordan, from Lane County Public Health, gave a presentation on strategies being used to reduce tobacco use in Lane County. She discussed the passage of the recent tobacco ordinance which regulates e-cigarettes and creates a tobacco retailer licensing process.
